Portable spa pre-move instructions and disclaimers

1. Drain the spa completely prior to our arrival time.
2. Turn the power off from the main box and unwire the spa if it is 220v or unplug the spa if its 110v. We can refer an electrician if needed.
3. Please remove anything that will be in the delivery path such as dog houses, sheds, garbage containers, patio furniture etc.
4. Have all vehicles out of the way so we may park safely.
5. Please let us know if there is anything in the way that cannot be removed such as plants, sprinklers, walls, decks, ac units, low roofs, etc.
6. If the spa has a cover lifter, please remove it (we can remove and reinstall it for a \$30 fee.)
7. If you have a screen or enclosed porch, measure that the spa will have more than an inch of clearance in all areas. If not, doors, door frames, or screens will need to be removed. We can also refer a screen guy if needed. We cannot be held responsible for scratches to the tubs or enclosures due to lack of clearance.
8. During the move of the spa please allow our technicians to do the work; this is why you are paying us.
9. If a secondary appointment is needed because of the lack of preparation, a service charge will occur.

Atlas Billiard Service is fully licensed and insured and will repair or have repaired any damages due to negligence on our part, however, we cannot be held responsible for damages incurred during our service due to lack of spa shell or cabinet integrity, or inadequate repairs. We take every precaution to insure the safety of your spa, however, water, sunlight, chemicals, weathering, etc. can cause overall weakening or rotting of the spa and its components.
